13: UAS Operator Recurrent ((UGR) Exam Preparation

Course Overview

Thousands of Remote Pilots have become certified since the passage of the law known as Part 107. Under the provisions of 14CFR§107.73, certified remote pilots (UAG) must pass a recurrent exam (UGR) each 24 calendar months from the issuance of the original remote pilot certificate. The Recurrent exam will test the remote pilot's knowledge and understanding of seven of the original twelve study areas. This course is available as online video training (approx 2 hours) or on-site presentation (4-6 hours).

This course will cover the following topics:

Applicable FAA regulations relating to Small UAS Rating Privileges, Limitations and Flight Operations, Airspace Classifications and Operating Requirements, Emergency Procedures, Crew Resource Management, Aeronautical Decision Making and Judgment, Airport Operations and UAS Maintenance.

Course Objective

To prepare the student operator for real-world safe operation of Small (multi-rotor and fixed wing) UAV and to provide basic study in preparation for passing the Recurrent Remote Pilot Certification under FAR Part §107.
